Here is a young bird from West Island, Cocos Island, seen on the 30th November 2016. It has a washed chest and a wide large bill unlike the Grey-streaked or Dark-sided. The eye ring has an upper and lower ring unlike the subject birds. The wing tips just reach the tail. The neck collar is white and very distinct unlike the subject birds of cases 1079, 1080, 1081 and 1082.
